This melody and text are often assumed to be a folk song which usually implies that they are of unknown origin. There is proof, however, that Elder Joseph Brackett, a citizen of Maine and member of the Shaker community in the 19th century, is the composer of both the words and tune. The melody became world famous primarily through American composer Aaron Copland who included it in his ballet score *Appalachian Spring* in 1944.
